Please note that the break times are as follows:

Morning Tea - 11.30am-12.00pm, Lunch - 1.10pm-2.00pm

Picking your child up during the school day is discouraged. It disrupts the learning of other children in the learning space when a child leaves, or we have to phone the classroom.

If it is essential to pick your child up for an urgent appointment or other urgent reason, please alert the office ahead of time, and if possible pick your child up at the start or end of these break times, as it is very difficult to find students when they are outside playing.
